Poldhu (Mrs James' class) move to Year 2 and become Marazion (taught by Miss Uren)

Gwithian (Mrs Keast's class) move to Year 2 and become Portreath (taught by Miss Yelland)

Marizion (Miss Uren's class) move to Year 3 and become Truro (taught by Miss Curnow and Mrs Kennedy)

Portreath (Miss Yelland's class) move to Year 3 and become Coverack (taught by Miss Kessell)

Truro (Miss Curnow/ Mrs Kennedy Class) move to Year 4 and become Falmouth (taught by Mrs Dagg)

Coverack (Miss Kessell's class) move to Year 4 and become Newlyn (taught by Mrs Hammill)

Falmouth (Mrs Dagg's class) move to Year 5 and become St Piran (taught by Miss Morris-Marsham)

Newlyn (Mr Savage's class) move to Year 5 and become St Blazey (taught by Mr Forder)

St Piran (Miss Morris-Marsham's class) move to Year 6 and become St Petroc (Tutor—Mrs Williams)

St Blazey (Mr Forder's class) will move to Year 6 and become Helston (Tutor—Mrs Thomas)

At Roskear, Year 6 children are set in tutor groups for registration and afternoon lessons however, for English and maths, they are 'set' and therefore will have either Mrs Thomas, Mrs Williams or Mrs Bonds.
