### Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for your support and patience at this extremely uncertain time. The school <u>will</u> remain open until we are formally asked to close by the Department For Education or we cannot staff the safe supervision of children. Please see the latest guidance released last night:

We are advising those who are at increased risk of severe illness from coronavirus (COVID-19) to be particularly stringent in following social distancing measures.

This group includes those who are:

- aged 70 or older (regardless of medical conditions)
- under 70 with an underlying health condition listed below (i.e. anyone instructed to get a flu jab as an adult each year on medical grounds):
- chronic (long-term) respiratory diseases, such as <u>asthma</u>, <u>chronic obstructive pulmonary disease</u> (COPD), emphysema or <u>bronchitis</u>
- chronic heart disease, such as heart failure
- chronic kidney disease
- chronic liver disease, such as <u>hepatitis</u>
- chronic neurological conditions, such as <u>Parkinson's disease</u>, <u>motor neurone disease</u>, <u>multiple sclerosis (MS)</u>, a learning disability or cerebral palsy
- diabetes
- problems with your spleen for example, <u>sickle cell</u> disease or if you have had your spleen removed
- a weakened immune system as the result of conditions such as <u>HIV and AIDS</u>, or medicines such as <u>steroid tablets</u> or <u>chemotherapy</u>
- being seriously overweight (a BMI of 40 or above)
- those who are pregnant

ALL visits/trips/camps in April and up to May half term will be postponed and all money paid will be refunded to you asap. This means that with regret Porthpean Camp for Year 4 has been cancelled.

We will undertake Easter bingo with the children during the school day between now and Friday at no cost. Changes to where packed lunches will be eaten may occur, for example, KS2 children are likely to be eating in classrooms (every child will wash their hands prior to eating and tables will be sanitised).
