## **School Uniform - January**

Roskear has a very clear expectation in relation to school uniform, which is present on the school website, however both myself and the Chair of Governors have noticed a large number of pupils not wearing the expected uniform. Trainers are not part of the school uniform apart from when engaged in a PE lesson. Children are required to wear black school shoes. Royal blue fleeces, sweaters, jumpers and cardigans may be worn but hoodies and other non-royal blue fleeces may not be worn unless they are to take the role of a coat, in which case they will not be worn in the classroom. Earrings are only to be simple studs or sleeper earrings (small close to the lob hoops). Hanging, dangling earrings may not be worn as they may be accidentally tugged or ripped out when children are playing. Please can we all start the new year wearing the specified uniform.
