'Reading in Reception'

Dear Parent / Carer,

Your child is now bringing a reading book home to share. Learning to read is one of the most exciting and important skills they will ever learn in school and we are thrilled to share their reading experiences with you. We encourage the children to share their book with you every day. Initially, we expect the adults to read the words in the book and talk about the text and pictures. You might wish to ask your child questions about the story or information within the book. Many of our books have question prompts and ideas at the back and these can be very helpful.

Your child will choose new reading books throughout the week. Please return books once your child has finished reading them and they will then be able to choose another one to share. It will be great if they can keep this in their reading book bag and bring it to school each day. Our staff will help the children to change their reading book on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

We will keep a record of the books your child has read and we shall also post reading information on our class eSchools page. For example,

- How can you support your child's reading at home?
- What does Read, Write, Inc. (RWI) in the classroom look like?
- RWI e-books
