

## The Equality Act, 2010 (England)

## It is against the law to discriminate against anyone because of

- age
- gender reassignment
- being married or in a civil partnership
- being pregnant or on maternity leave
- disability
- race, including colour, nationality, ethnic or national origin
- religion or belief
- sex
- sexual orientation

## These are called 'protected characteristics'
